

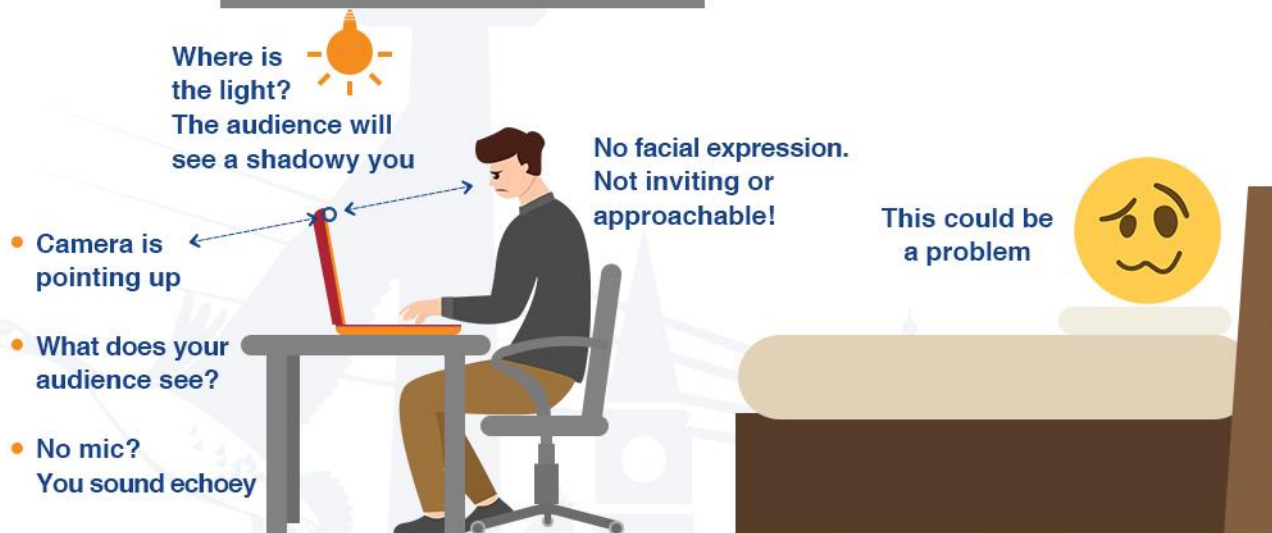

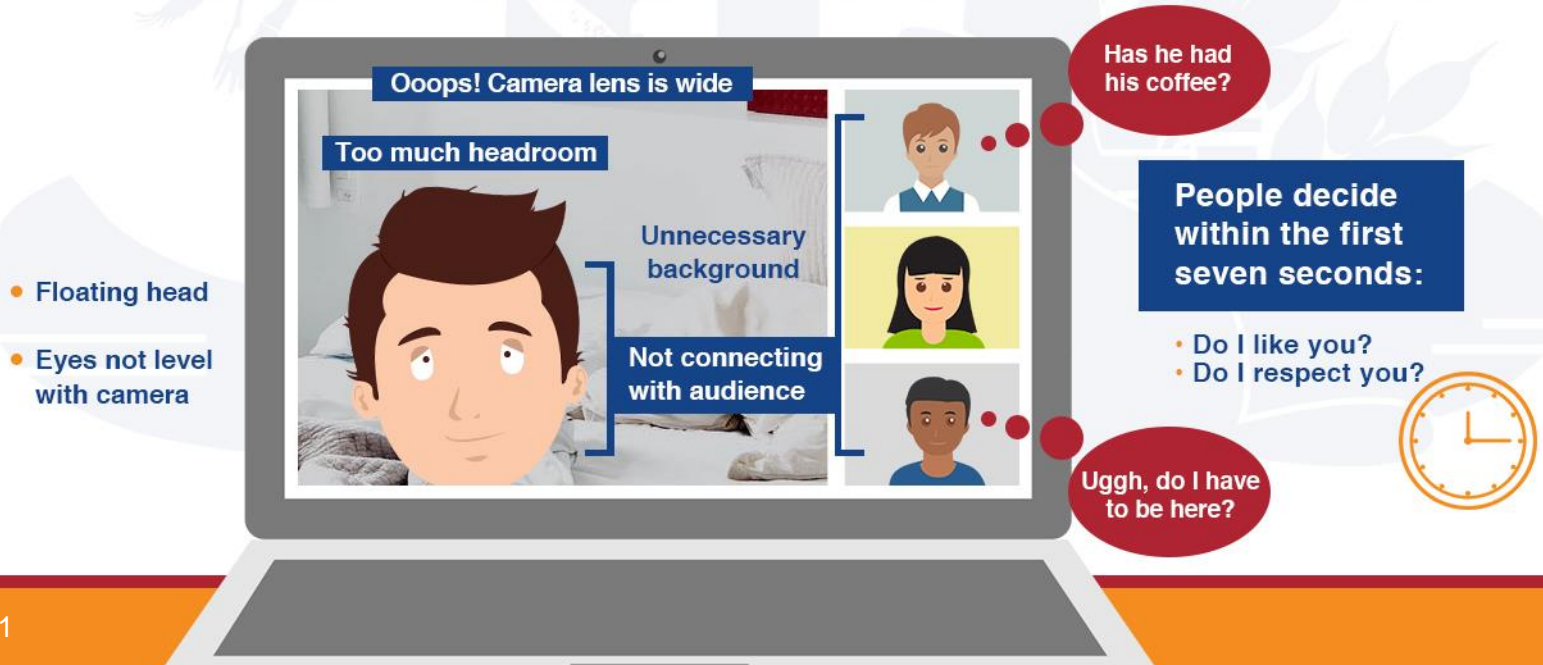

Setting the Tone Virtually Checklist

- ✓ Eye level with camera
- ✓ You are well lit
- ✓ Do your facial expressions match your words and tone? (We read faces first before we hear the words)
- ✓ What's behind you?
- ✓ Microphone. Even the mic that comes with your earphones is better than the computer
- ✓ Test run
